### **BRLT announces auditions for “Almost, Maine”**

(Baton Rouge) – The Baton Rouge Little Theater, or BRLT, will hold auditions for “Almost, Maine,” on Sunday, Dec. 10, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. and Monday, Dec. 11, 2011 at 7 p.m. Auditions will be held on the Second Stage.

Under the direction of Keith Dixon, the performances will run from Jan. 27 – Feb. 12, 2011. The play is regularly performed with four actors in their late twenties/early thirties playing six to seven roles each. However, casting is flexible with parts for as many as 19 actors at various ages. Actual casting is open and will depend on audition turnout.

On a cold, clear, moonless night in the middle of winter, all is not quite what it seems in the remote, mythical town of Almost, Maine. As the northern lights hover in the star-filled sky above, Almost's residents find themselves falling in and out of love in unexpected and often hilarious ways. Knees are bruised and hearts are broken. In the end, bruises heal, and the hearts mend—almost—in this delightful midwinter night's dream.
