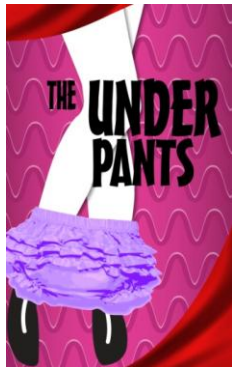

BRLT's announces auditions for, "The Underpants"

(Baton Rouge) – The Baton Rouge Little Theater, or BRLT, is holding open auditions for Steve Martin's, "The Underpants," on Sunday, Jan. 22, at 7 p.m. Under the direction of Kurt Hauschild, performances will run April 13-22, 2012, on the Second Stage.

Participants are encouraged to be familiar with the script for auditions. Scripts are available for check out at the Box Office with a \$20 refundable deposit. Call backs are scheduled for Tuesday, Jan. 4, at 7 p.m. Rehearsals are to begin late February, early March.

Cast needs: **Theo Maske**- A Burly, muscular fireplug with a buzz cut; **Louise Maske**- Very pretty, mid-twenties, Theo's wife; **Gertrude Deuter**- Forty-two and a busybody; **Frank Versati**- An Elegant gentleman; **Benjamin Cohen**- Sickly, thin, asthmatic; **Klingehoff**- An elderly man.

The renowned comedic actor and author of "Picasso at the Lapine Agile," provide a wild satire adapted from the classic German play about Louise and Theo Markes, a couple whose conservative existence is shattered when Louise's bloomers fall down in public. Though she pulls them up quickly, he thinks the incident will cost him his job as a government clerk. Louise's momentary display does not result in the feared scandal but it does attract two infatuated men, each of whom wants to rent the spare room in the Markes' home. Oblivious of their amorous objectives, Theo splits the room between them, happy to collect rent from both the foppish poet and the whiny hypochondriac.
